

Rebecca Barnett serves as an Instructor for the Muscogee (Creek) Nation Language Preservation Department. Rebecca teaches the Mvskoke language to adults, college students and Head Start students. Rebecca began teaching the Mvskoke language at Connors State College and Petake Vcake Immersion School. She studied Native American Studies at the College of the Muscogee Nation and graduated with top honors. Afterwards she began teaching at the College of Muscogee Nation and continues to teach there today.

She teaches the language at the Muscogee (Creek) Nation Language Department over lunch for employees of the Nation or anyone interested in learning the language. To learn the language, she also teaches Head Start schools in the Muscogee (Creek) Nation jurisdiction. Rebecca was raised by a traditional Mvskoke-speaking family and has been speaking her language since childhood.

Rebecca is married and has three daughters and eight grandchildren that she is teaching the language and has taught her daughters the traditional Mvskoke life as she was taught. To carry on the traditional ways and language to be carried on in her family and hoping that they will teach everything they learned to the next generation.
